

Hello Friends and Members of Holy Trinity Church,

This is an important message about the restart of our Eucharist services at Holy Trinity Church, Roehampton.


We are delighted that we will be holding services in church, once more, from **Sunday 9<sup>th</sup> August 2020**. The Eucharist service will be held at **10.00am on each Sunday**. As you might expect, there will be significant differences from the last time you were at Holy Trinity Church, Roehampton. Despite these necessary Covid-19 safe precautions, we intend to make the service as similar as possible to our past worship and warmly look forward to welcoming and seeing everyone once again.

Do please come slightly earlier than you might normally do, to allow us to get everyone seated safely and in time for a 10.00am start. We recommend trying to arrive by 9.45am at the latest.

### ARRIVAL

- The Church 'North Door' will be open from 9.00am (the North Door is the disabled entrance higher up Ponsonby Road see map below) and entry into church is via this door only.  
Sidespersons will be on hand to help and direct. The sidespersons will allow one person (or family group) into the North Door vestibule at a time. There are 1m spacing/queueing markers outside the church to help keep distance.
- As you come into the North Door vestibule, there will be someone to 'sign you in' and take your email or phone number for *Track and Trace* purposes.
- Please ensure you use the hand sanitiser supplied and then you will be given the service sheet.
- This will be YOUR service sheet for the coming weeks. You should take it home and bring it with you on following Sundays.
- We strongly advise that you bring your OWN mask or face coverings and put this on before entering the church and continue to wear it throughout the worship. There will be a small number of masks available in the vestibule (for a donation) for those who may have forgotten to bring one.

- A second sidesperson will lead you to a church pew. Please maintain the 1m social distancing rules, when coming and leaving the church and when seated.
- Households can sit together as one group. You may stand or sit at any point in the service but we advise not moving around the church unless necessary.
- The toilet will be available for use. We will expect anyone using the toilet to sanitise the facilities after their use. There will be sanitising spray/cleaning products made available and instructions displayed.

### SERVICE

- During the service there will be music. Sadly, members of the congregation are not allowed to sing and there will be no hymn books supplied.
- The kneelers have also been removed for safety purposes.
- During the Peace please avoid all physical contact/greeting – it is expected that all remain in their place and turn to those around them to exchange the peace verbally or by gesture.
- We will be having a limited Eucharist – with no wine but the bread can be taken. The Vicar will explain the procedure at the start of the service to all.
- A collection will not be taken during the service but you are warmly invited to leave a contribution in the Collection Plates on leaving the church.
- During August, the Sunday School is on its annual leave. How we will return with the Sunday School is to be decided at the beginning of September.

### LEAVING

- Unfortunately, we are unable to offer 'coffee' at the end of the service. Sidespersons will usher each row to leave one-by-one, following the signposted one-way route.
- We are putting these procedures in place to provide a safe environment in which to worship and we hope that you will feel reassured by them.
- For those who do not yet feel ready to return to church services, we will be streaming our worship on our Facebook page.
